With the passage of Special Act 22-8, the Hydrogen Task Force was created to study hydrogen-fueled energy in the state's economy and energy infrastructure. By January 15, 2023, the Hydrogen Task Force shall submit a report on its findings and recommendations to the joint standing committee the General Assembly. The Task Force is supported by activity from 5 Working Groups: Policy & Workforce Development; Funding; Hydrogen Sources; Hydrogen Infrastructure; Hydrogen Uses.
